Overview of Objectives

- To maintain and promote a successful recycling program that will be consistent, uniform and sustainable.
- To provide an understanding of existing recycling programs developed in the County to include program ownership, participation levels, costs and any other information deemed pertinent by the committee.
- To research other program options or alternatives.
- To explore recycling grants for education, recycling expansion and household hazardous waste collection events.
- To benchmark program data to include type, participation, and costs.
- To develop and submit recommendations to the Madison County Board of Supervisors for review on a quarterly basis.
