### EMS Calls: October 1 through October 31, 2012:

#### Day coverage:

Total calls **toned: 108**

Total calls **handled: 105**

Total calls, **no response: 3**

- 2 Greene County and 1 Orange County calls for mutual aid assistance were not answered.

Average In-County response time to the scene: **9 minutes.**

#### Night coverage:

Eleven hours of night coverage on **24 nights**

Total calls **handled: 27**
