

Hoover Ridge Park — Phased Projects

Hoover Ridge Park, a unique and beautiful public facility, consists of 182-acres. Purchased by the Board of Supervisors, this property holds historical significance and serves as a community gathering space. Completion of Phase One at Hoover Ridge Park currently includes:

- Walking & Running Trails
- “Camp Crocket”, a Scout Camp & Small Amphitheater
- Farmers’ Market
- Pond
- Sports Playing fields (Soccer, Baseball/Softball/ and Football)

At this time the Carpenter Foundation has donated \$13,500 for a pavilion to honor James P. and Frankie C. Carpenter. This is to be completed when more funding is available.

Phase Two Projects — 5-year plan begins Fall 2012--each year planned and budgeted at \$115,000.




Help us and the community turn a dream into reality—another completed phase at Hoover Ridge Park!
