

Madison County Recreation Authority Sport Participant/Parent/Guardian Guidelines

Parent Responsibilities:

1. Parent/Guardian is responsible for having participant at all practices and games on time.
2. Parent/Guardian is responsible for picking participant up at the time designated by the manager for dismissal from practice or game.
3. Parent/Guardian is responsible for providing a contact number that they/ or designee may be reached at, if they will not be attending game/practice that day. This is for emergency reasons, weather conditions, etc.
4. Parent/Guardian is responsible for their conduct at all times. Do not berate, curse, or defame a coach, your participant, other participant's, other coaches, or anyone associated with the youth program. Please remember, we are the adults and must set a positive example for our children.
5. Parent/Guardian is responsible for the conduct of the participant.
6. Parent/Guardian is responsible for helping with concessions and fundraisers if so designated throughout the year.
7. Parent/Guardian is responsible for requesting a private meeting with a coach (not a public meeting) for any problems concerning their participant. Our coaches will not discuss playing position, starting lineup, or other participants with a parent. Most discussions should focus on what all parties can do to help participants advance their skills and enjoyment of the game.
8. Parent/Guardian is responsible for letting their coach know if they will be able to participate in all-stars if chosen. Parent/Guardian will be responsible for any additional funds required for all-stars.
9. Parent/Guardian is responsible for following the rules and regulations of a suspension from the participant's school. The Participant will not be allowed to participate in Madison County Recreation Authority Programs/Sports/Events if they are suspended after school hours from their school or excluded from extra-curricular activities due to their suspension from their school.

Violation of Responsibilities will result in the removal of participant and parent/guardian from the league or in the case of 1 and 2 above – participant may be suspended for a game/inning at coach's discretion. The commissioner will make all decisions concerning violation of Parent/Guardian Responsibilities.
